Primary talking: Be a good example (Follow Me: November 3rd) During Christmas, some people have an elf on the shelf. The elf is a spy for Santa Claus! He watches what happens in the house every day and then reports to Santa every night. The elf notices if the kids are naughty or pretty. We don't need an elf watching us so he knows we have to be good. Jesus has asked us to be a good example! He wants us to live like Him. The scriptures tell us: Be an example to believers, in word, in behavior, in charity, in faith, in purity.1 This means that we must use good plain language, say good words, help people when they need help, keep the commandments, listen to the Holy Ghost, and keep our covenants. When we are a good example to others, it can help our friends and family make good choices. We can show that we believe in Jesus Christ by acting like him. I hope that I can be an example of a believer and that I can make Jesus proud. Hearts are really important. Your heart pumps blood all over your body. Blood brings life to your organs. This keeps the body alive. We all want to have healthy hearts. One thing I love about The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints is that gospel teachings are the same all over the world. The Church of Jesus Christ shares a global message that applies to everyone and to everyone, regardless of their location, age, race, or marital status. With the introduction of the new Come Follow Me 2019 curriculum, this concept of compliance worldwide is even more obvious. A few years ago, my husband was assigned to take special training at the center, just outside New Orleans, Louisiana. It was six weeks, so we decided to take the whole family so we could be together. I thought moving from Utah to busy Louisiana (even for a short time) would be pretty crazy! And I'll be honest, there were some things that caused a bit of a cultural shock. But the first Sunday we went into it was like being transported back home. The Church Building was exactly the same scheme as our building in Utah! The members of the area were hospitable and kind. In Relief Society, they got away with the clipboard, and I signed up to bring a dish of sweat to Halloween. Primary children even learn to sing the same songs they taught in our home. But, more than the cultural and physical similarities, the Spirit is the same, and the gospel messages were consistent with the messages given at home and thought the world. I think it is such a testimony of the truthfulness of the gospel that it can be preached everywhere and recognized as truth without being changed to adapt to location traditions and customs. Every ward doesn't need Relief Society clipboards with signatures and printed ballots. Some children may sing Primary songs to play a ukulele or a recorded CD instead of a live piano. In fact, ward members can even meet under the shade of a grass hut or at the back of a commercial building! But all the truths taught in Sunday meetings come from the Lord's guidance. This is truly the Lord's Church on earth. And His message is learned every week.
